2.22.010 **Position Created.** There is created the position of City Administrator who may be an appointive officer of the City. The Mayor may appoint with concurrence of the majority of Council the City Administrator when the City Council determines the best interest of the City would be served by such appointment. The City Administrator may be an employee, independent contractor, individual corporation, and may serve without bond providing for the administration of city services, personnel, and such other responsibilities as may be delegated by the Mayor or City Council, or designated herein as "superintendent", "administrator", or "authorized designee of the Mayor".
