A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF BENTON CITY PROPERTY SURPLUS TO CITY NEEDS

WHEREAS, there are certain items of City property and equipment surplus to City needs; NOW, THERFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENTON CITY, WASHINGTON, hereby resolves as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The items of City property and equipment listed in Exhibit A, attached hereto, are declared surplus property, and the City staff is authorized to sell such property at a price that is in the best interest of the City.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The City staff is hereby authorized to dispose of said surplus property through one of the following methods:
 - A. By transfer to a governmental agency.
 - B. In trade as credit toward the purchase of a like article.
- C. By sale through competitive sealed bid, public or private sale, consignment or internet auction.

For any surplus property that is not sold, the City may sale the surplus property for salvage or junk the surplus property that cannot be sold.
